## GENERAL REGULATIONS

The Nordics will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2016, the ISU Special Regulations & Technical Rules for Figure Skating & Ice Dance 2016, as well as all updated ISU Communications.

Participation in the **The Nordics** is open to all Junior Ladies & Men and Advanced Novice Girls & Boys belonging to the following ISU Members:

**Norges Skøyteforbund**  
**Svenska Konståkningsförbundet**  
**Suomen Taitoluisteliitto**  
**Dansk Skøjte Union**  
**Íslenska Skautasambandið**

and qualify with regard to eligibility according to ISU Rule 102, provided their ages fall within the limits specified in Rule 108, paragraph 3 b) and they meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in ISU Rule 109, paragraphs 1 through 5 and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of this Communication.

**Passports/EU ID cards of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.**

## TECHNICAL DATA

**PLACE**     **Main arena (MR): Lappi Areena**, Hiihtomajantie 6 96400 Rovaniemi  
An indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 28 x 58 m, air-conditioned and heated,

**Practice arena (PR): Lappi Areena**, Hiihtomajantie 6 96400 Rovaniemi  
An indoor ice-rink with the ice surface of 26 x 56 m, air-conditioned and heated

The main venue is located 3 km from the City Center of Rovaniemi, and 10 km from Rovaniemi International Airport.

## JUNIOR CATEGORIES

**JUNIOR MEN**     Short Program     The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2016 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2017/18.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating     In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2016, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 4 min., +/- 10 sec.

**JUNIOR LADIES** Short Program     The required elements to be skated are those listed in ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2016 Rule 611, paragraphs 1 and 3 for 2017/18.

Duration: 2 min., 40 sec., +/- 10 sec.

Free Skating     In accordance with ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2016, Rule 612 and the respective ISU Communication. Special attention should be paid to the "well balanced program" and the element value.

Duration: 3 min., 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.

## NOVICE CATEGORIES

**ADVANCED NOVICE BOYS**     Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair 2016 and ISU Communication 2024. Age requirements according to ISU Communication 2024. Figure Skating Guidelines 2016 for international Novice Competitions.

**Short program duration**     2 min. and 20 sec., +/- 10 sec.

**Free Skating duration**     3 min. and 30 sec., +/- 10 sec.



**ADVANCED NOVICE GIRLS** Requirements according to the ISU Technical Rules Single & Pair 2016 and ISU Communication 2024. Age requirements according to ISU Communication 2024. Figure Skating Guidelines 2016 for international Novice Competitions.

**Short program duration** 2 min. and 20 sec., +/- 10 sec.  
**Free Skating duration** 3 min. +/- 10 sec.

## ENTRIES

The preliminary entries must be send through this [weblink](#). Preliminary Entries of Competitors, Judges and Technical Panels must be sent to the Organizer by **November 30<sup>th</sup> 2017 – 20:00 local time Finland**.

All links and forms are available latest from November 13th, 2017 on the competition website [www.stil.fi/luistelijalle/nordics-2018](http://www.stil.fi/luistelijalle/nordics-2018).

Complete Final Entry Forms must reach the organizer by **January 3<sup>rd</sup> 2018 – 20:00 local time Finland** at the latest.

### Entries of competitors

Citizen / Residence requirements and Clearance Procedure: In accordance with Rule 109 of ISU Regulations and ISU Communication 2030 or any update of it, all skaters who do not have the Nationality of the Member, which they have been entered or who although having such nationality, have in the past representing another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Each invited Member from the Nordic countries has the right to enter competitors as follows:

**4 Junior Men**  
**4 Junior Ladies**

**4 Novice Boys**  
**4 Novice Girl**

The registration of all competitors must be entered and all judges nominated only through their respective Member Association/Federation. The age of each competitor must be stated on the Entry Form and be clearly documented.

### Entries of officials

The host Nordic country member is responsible for appointing Referees and Technical panels for all categories, following initial suggestions from the Nordic country members as well as for the appointment of the Judges panels.

Each Nordic country member is responsible for providing at least one (1) international or ISU level judge, and at least one (1) technical panel member, but maximum two (2) Technical Controllers or Specialists.

The Host country completes the panels of Officials according to the ISU Rules and relevant Communications regarding world standing points and officials' activity.

### Entry fee

The entry fee is **75 €** per skater and a minimum of **250 €** per Nordic Member. In addition each Nordic country pays a contribution of **500 €**.

The entry fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawals for any reason. Entry fee must be paid by **January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018** through individual web-link you will be given after you have submitted the preliminary entry.

## EXPENSES

Each participating Member must bear all expenses for their Competitors, Judges, Technical Panel (TC/TS/DO/RO), Team Leaders and Coaches. The meals (lunch and dinner) and pocket money for the Technical Panel members are borne by the Organizer.

If a Nordic country does not provide a judge and a technical panel person from their own country, the Country must cover the costs of one judge/technical panel person invited by the organizer. Travel and accommodation expenses will be paid only for the invited Referees, invited Technical Panel Members and invited Judges from outside Nordic countries.

Hotel rooms must be booked through the Organizer **only**.



## MUSIC / PLANNED PROGRAM CONTENT

In accordance with Rule 343, paragraph 1 all Competitors shall furnish competition music of excellent quality in digital audio file. Music files must be submitted on CD or any other transportable independent free accessible medium on site at the time of registration. The medium with the music files will be kept until the end of the competition.

Each program (short/free) must be recorded on one track respectively on a separate disc. Discs must show the competition event, competitors name, nation and the exact running time of the music (not skating time) including any starting signal.

If music information is not complete and/or the music is not provided, accreditation will not be given.

The "Planned Program Content Sheet" and "Music Information form" must be returned with the entry forms no later than **January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018**. The Planned Program Content Sheet must be filled in precisely by each skater in English using the Terminology for the elements listed in the respective ISU Communication. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

The Organizing Committee kindly asks all Members to send their National Anthem, thank you.

Please return music (prefer to mp3 or mp4), Music Information form and Planned Program Content sheet no later than **January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018** through individual web-link you will be given after you have submitted the preliminary entry.

## REGISTRATION

Accreditation will be given to all Referees, Judges, Technical Panels, Competitors, Team Leaders, Coaches and Representatives from each Member Federation. Accreditation will be given at the official hotel upon arrival.

## RESULTS and FREE SKATING STARTING ORDER

Judging and calculations will be done according to ISU Special Regulations Single & Pair Skating and Ice Dance 2016, Rules 352 and 353.

The starting order for the Free Skating and Free Dance will be in reverse order of the result of the Short Program/Dance according to ISU Rule 513 2.

## AWARDS

The three best-placed Competitors in each event will be announced and honored at the official Victory Ceremony. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be presented to the medalists. The national anthem of the winner will be played and the flag of the medal winners hoisted.

## LIABILITY

In accordance with ISU Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each member participation in The Nordics 2018, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious means. The Organizer assumes no responsibility for or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or property damage incurred by competitors and officials.

## ANTI-DOPING

Anti-Doping tests may be carried out in accordance with the current ISU Anti-Doping Rules and Procedures (ISU Communication 1922 and 2117 or any further update of this Communication)



## ACCOMMODATION AND MEALS

Banquet for the Officials, coaches and skaters will be held on **Friday evening** at the SantaSport hotel. The dinner cost is 20 €/ person. If participant does not order lunch for Friday, the price is 30 €/ person.

All meal tickets must be booked by each Member through individual web-link you will be given after you have submitted the preliminary entry and meals must be paid by **January 10<sup>th</sup>, 2018**.

Meal tickets will be distributed to the Team Leaders at the time of registration according to bookings. Locations for meals will be announced in due time.

## TRANSPORTATION

The international airport in Rovaniemi (RVN) is 10 km from Santasport.
